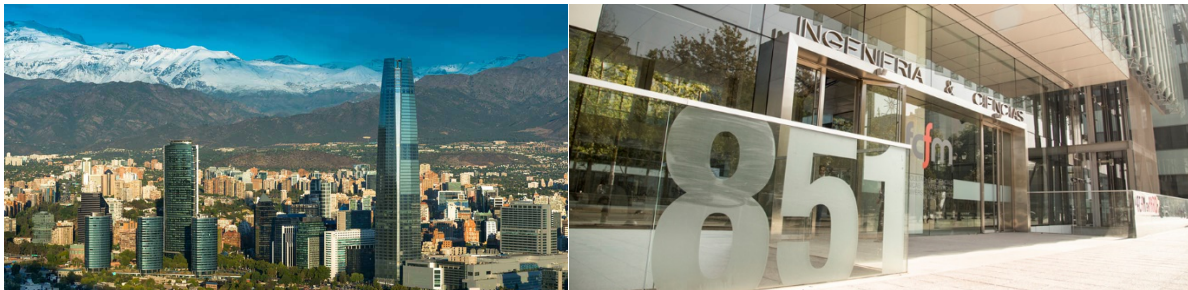
The Global Emission Initiative's efforts to accelerate societal transformations
